

The following categories will be available for racing:

Junior Men 10-12	Junior Women 10-12

Junior Men 15-16	Junior Women 15-16
Junior Men 17-18	Junior Women 17-18
Espoir Men 19-22	Espoir Women 19-22

For the road race and the criterium there will be two fields of juniors with combined age groups. LAJOR medals will be awarded based on the separate age groups. Monetary prizes for the Junior group B will be for the combined field. See website for prize lists. The groups will be:
Junior group A—Junior men 15-16, 17-18, Junior women 17-18, and Espoir men and women 19-22
Junior group B—Junior men 10-12, 13-14 and Junior women 10-12, 13-14, 15-16

Friday, July 22

20K Time Trial - First rider off at 5:30pm. You **MUST** pre-register through Active.com (shorter course is pending for younger juniors; see website for updated details)

Saturday, July 23

18 mile Road Race- Junior group A will race at 10:15
Junior group B will race at 10:25

* We realize that 18 miles is rather short for group B, however, due to scheduling it was the best we could do, we encourage those riders to compete in the category races as well—see discounts below.

Criterium—Junior group B will race at 8:00am for 25 min

Junior As who wish to race in the Pro/ Cat 1,2, Cat 3, and Women 1-3 Road Race and Criterium in addition to their junior race can do so for \$20.00 each race. This discount will only be done at on site registration and only for Juniors who registered online for the Junior Omnium. The time trial can not count for two different categories, however, since you only have to compete in two events for the omnium you would qualify for the omnium in both the Juniors and your category omnium. If you do the math, you will save money versus registering for the category omnium and adding the junior races (see website for fees of the category races).
